UHUP Student Parliament Annual Work Plan for the academic year
2019/2020.



The Student Parliament on 08.10.2018 participated in a roundtable organized by the OSCE - Mission in Kosovo, on the topic "Conversation about" us "and" them "between University students and young people representing different religions".

At this roundtable, we discussed similarities and differences in students' lifestyles, promotion of acceptance, and mutual understanding.

During the roundtable discussion, we expressed our thoughts on our situation at the University in terms of differences in religions.



Within the curriculum of the Faculty of Life Sciences and Environment, students from the Department of Forest Sciences and Agronomy, together with the academic staff conducted two study visits dated 04.11.2018.

The first part of the Agribusiness management visit was to the “Agroproduct” Business Enterprise based in Istog/Istok Municipality. A success story to take as an example that in our Republic we can succeed with honest work.

An Albanian from the Albanian Diaspora (Switzerland) has set up a production company, namely the collection of aromatic and medicinal herbs and mountain fruits, where the company employs around 3700 workers (by European standards) employed at all stages starting from the collection to processing, in all regions of Kosovo.

The second part of the visit took place in the forest seed plot of the Kosovo Forest Institute in Arabra, Peja. The students were welcomed by the staff of the Forest Institute where they were introduced to the processes of production of forest seedlings from seed treatment, planting, seedling care, health aspects and their preparation for transport to the forest site.



On 06.11.2018 the Faculty of Education visited the Clock Tower, Archaeological Museum in Prizren.

Headed by Student Parliament Speaker Milot Krasniqi, President of Faculty Council of Education, Fatlind Tredhaku and Council Member Arbnore Gashi, some students visited Clock Tower - Archaeological Museum in Prizren. Students were informed that the Museum treats archaeological material from archaeological sites of the Prizren region, respectively from the municipalities of Prizren, Dragash, Rahovec and Suhareka.

Background

The Archaeological Museum is housed in the hammam, built in the late 15th century, in 1498, respectively. The builder of the hammam is supposed to be Shemsudin Ahmed Bey. In the absence of written sources, it is not known until what year it was used as a hammam, but it is known that the hammam did not perform its original function in the middle of the XIX century when the clock tower was built on the warm space by Ashraf Pasha Rotulli. During the archaeological excavations carried out in 2003, on the south side of the building were found remains of the cold area (entrance) of the hammam on which the residential building was built. On the basis of this fact, it can be concluded that the hammam was partially ruined since the XIX century.

This was the first visit of the Student Parliament to this cultural facility in the historic city of Prizren. These visits will already have an educational character and will be routine for Parliament.



Students of the Law Faculty, divided into two groups, dated 06.11.2018 and 07.11.2018, visited the Basic Court of Prizren.

Students of the Law Faculty, led by the President of the Council of the Law Faculty, Lindon Behluli and the member of this Council, Albana Shala, visited the Basic Court in Prizren.

Students during the visit were introduced to the work done by this court and the judges within the departments. At the Court, both groups of the Faculty were welcomed by the spokeswoman for information, Mrs. Aferdita Kicaj. Also discussed were the novelties brought about by the reform of the judicial system, such as opportunities for direct meetings with the court president and active public participation.

Students of the University of Prizren, Faculty of Law, have a tradition of visiting this Court, thanking at the same time for the cooperation.



On 13.11.2018 students of the Faculty of Computer Sciences, headed by the President of the Student Parliament Mr. Milot Krasniqi and the President of the Council of this Faculty, Ermal Krasniqi and the Council member Arita Zogjani visited the Digital School.

The Digital School is focused on providing the highest level of quality in teaching and customer service. Students of the Faculty of Computer Science were informed that the Digital School is a MEST accredited course for development of skills in Computer Science and Programming with a level-based syllabus lasting 3 years.

It is worth noting that the Digital School has offered internships to students of the Faculty of Computer Sciences.



On 14.11.2018 at the University of Prizren, namely the Faculty of Economics, in cooperation with the Student Parliament and the Student Council of the Faculty of Economics, the Minister of Innovation and Entrepreneurship Prof.Dr.Besim Beqaj, lectured on the topic "How to get into Business".

This event was also attended by the owner of the most successful enterprise in Prizren and beyond, the owner of "Abi Çarshia", Mr. Alajdin Fusha.

The guests were highly respected professors and students, where they had the opportunity to listen to these guests.

For the occasion, the highly respected professor, prof. Dr. Artan Nimani was invited, who emphasized that it is an honor for students to hear from Minister Beqaj about starting a business.

Minister Beqaj had a message for the students present, to believe in themselves, to create a job for others, and not to enter the job solely for themselves. This means that every student who is willing to open a business will have the full support of the Ministry of Innovation.

Also, the owner of the most successful Prizren enterprise "Abi Çarshia ", Mr. Fusha, outlined its challenges when setting up this enterprise, conveying many messages to students .

The Student Parliament and Student Council of the Faculty of Economics will remain a promoter of scientific organizations that are beneficial to our University students.



In honor of the 110th anniversary of the Congress of the Monastery, the Student Council of the Faculty of Education in cooperation with the Student Parliament organized a rich literary class.

On 13.12.2018 representatives of the Student Parliament visited Down Syndrome Center in Prizren (Down Syndrome Prizren), where they were greeted very warmly.

In this center we were closely acquainted with the activities taking place there and we saw that these persons do not lack talent.
